

Addiction Treatment Medications Approved By the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA):



Buprenorphine: It helps treat opioid addiction, reducing withdrawal symptoms and cravings. You may know it by its brand names: Suboxone and Subutex.

Methadone: It's used in clinics to manage opioid addiction. Methadone eases withdrawal symptoms and cravings.

Naltrexone: It's available in oral and injectable forms, and helps with alcohol and opioid addiction. Naltrexone blocks both substances' effects and reduces cravings.

Disulfiram: Designed specifically for alcohol addiction, disulfiram causes unpleasant reactions if alcohol is consumed, discouraging its use.

Acamprosate: It helps with alcohol addiction, reducing cravings and withdrawal symptoms and helping people stay sober.
